## ARIFJAN CONTAINER REPAIR FACILITY (ADLR) NAMED GEO LOC OF THE MONTH

Since assisting and creating the AUL geo-location (ADLR) in late November, SSG Michael Alsup and SPC Bruce May have completely revamped the organization and every day operations of the container repair yard. With the help of SPC Henry, who keeps the administrative duties running smooth, SSG Alsup and SPC May have increased efficiency in almost every aspect of the container repair process.

With the collaborative efforts of American United Logistics (AUL) employees; Kamal, Rashid Parkar, Hanif Sange and their repair crew; AUL has turned out 252 repaired containers since February 1st. When asked how the re-organization of the repair yard has

helped the repair process, Rashid states "it has greatly helped the operational efficiency by not having to categorize each individual container before repairs begin. The re-organization has greatly improved the repair planning process." He also adds that since SSG Alsup started assisting, they have no longer had a problem with identifying serial numbers of certain containers. SSG Alsup has helped facilitate communications between KBR and the AUL repair crew to identify the serial numbers of these previously unreadable containers.
